RULES

1. REGISTRATION

1.1. A maximum of two participants from a University or College is allowed to participate.

2. STRUCTURE

2.1. The competition is bilingual (English or Kannada), however, the same language should be followed throughout the speech by the participant.

2.2. Each participant will be given a time limit not exceeding 4 minutes .

2.3. There will be negative markings for exceeding the 4 minutes time limit.

2.4. Participants must choose and speak on either of the three topics.

3. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation will be provided only on request.

4. DRESS CODE

4.1. Formal and decent attire.

5. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Open to all college/university students pursuing UG courses.

6. CODE OF CONDUCT

6.1. Participants must bring their College ID cards for participation.

6.2. Reading out the speech from paper or use of any book, document, or electric gadget during the competition is not allowed.

6.3. The participants must refrain from disclosing their identities and their affiliations/institution till the end of the competition and at all times shall represent themselves by means of their respective team codes allotted to them during the course of the competition.

6.4. The participants must maintain professional decorum throughout the competition.

6.5. By registering for this competition, the participants shall be agreeing to all rules, terms, and conditions laid forth in this document and any further rules and conditions that the organizing committee may lay down further.

6.6. The judges decision shall be final.

6.7. Teams should not wear their college uniforms/blazers, indicating the name of the institute or mention the name of their institution during the competition.

6.8. Participating teams are prohibited from observing the performance of others until their designated turn is over.

7. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The speaker shall be adjudged out of 100 marks based on the following criteria:

7.1. Content (Clarity & Understanding of the Subject)

7.2. Oratory skills

7.3. Presentation skills

7.4. Structure and Time management

7.5. Analysis and reasoning (with regard to the developmental plans of Viksit Bharat)
