




Policy on the role of the Parents

In this regard, the college wishes to inform the parents on some of their duties and responsibilities:

1. The responsibility of your ward is exclusively yours; join us in moulding them for the better.
2. Be in touch with the Class teacher and the office at least once a month.
3. Meet the Class Teacher or Principal after each semester's results.
4. You must check the attendance and internal assessment performance on the website every month.
5. The college cannot personally communicate with every parent except in dire situations.
6. Check for new updates regarding internals, events, examinations, etc. on the college website regularly.
7. It is mandatory to attend the Annual Parents' meeting held at the college.
8. Both parents should be active in the official WhatsApp group created by the class teacher.
9. The subject-wise attendance of your ward can be accessed through the college website every month.
10. The results can be accessed by logging in to the college website using the student's examination registration number. The examination register number remains the same throughout the course.
11. Indiscriminate use of mobile devices is prohibited in the college. Students shall comply with Mobile etiquette; if not, it will be seized by the college for a period of time.
12. It is always advisable that you pay the college fees yourself.
13. Share with the class teacher any special ability or disability of your child without any hesitation.


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
