Report on the Induction Ceremony of MCS (16.10.2023)

The ceremony was hosted by the MCS convenor Ms. Shivani. The event began with an invocation rendered by Mr. Tejas after which the lighting of the lamp ensued. He emphasised the need for students to engage in both legal aid activities and moot court activities to hone their advocacy skills and expand their legal acumen. He urged us to be voracious readers and follow in the footsteps of the doyens at the Bar and to capitalise on the ever-evolving technological tools at our disposal. He concluded by calling upon the students to strive to realise their true potential.

Prof. Nataraju, our principal, gave the next address. He highlighted the importance of housing huge ambitions which serve to act as the driving force behind successful careers. He quoted Roscoe Pound to remind us that lawyers are ultimately social engineers who owe a huge duty to society.

After the speeches of the guests, badging ceremony commenced. The Induction Ceremony finally concluded with the release of the inter-class moot proposition for the academic year 2023-24 and a vote of thanks by Ms. Hemica.
